What are the specific details?

Duration	You have up to eight weeks to complete the course.
Venue	Run via distance learning and can therefore be fitted around work and personal life.
Cost	Free (fully government funded)*.

This qualification enables learners to improve their range of knowledge in certain health conditions. It also assists with the underpinning knowledge that is required by learners to function more effectively in a health and social care environment.

Who is this course suitable for?

Whether you are an experienced health care worker or new to the industry, caring for clients or patients in a work environment, this qualification will assist you with your personal development.

Do I need any experience?

There aren't any specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. However candidates ideally need to be working in health and social care or related sectors.
