

CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Falls Prevention Awareness

What are the specific details?

Duration	You have up to eight weeks to complete the course.
Venue	Run via distance learning and can therefore be fitted around work and personal life.
Cost	Free (fully government funded)*.

This qualification increases learners' awareness and understanding of falls and their prevention. Learners will gain knowledge and understanding of:

- the impact and consequences of a fall
- risks and hazards which contribute to falls
- reducing the risk of falls.

The qualification also covers the importance of recording and reporting any incidence of falls to ensure that interventions can be put in place to reduce the risk and reoccurrence of falls.

Who is this course suitable for?

This qualification is aimed at anyone working in a healthcare or social care environment, particularly those that support or have contact with older people who have an increased propensity to falls.

Do I need any experience?

There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification.

How is the course delivered?

The programme is delivered online or through a workbook by a range of assessments. These are assessed by the tutor throughout the programme from induction to completion.

What will I gain from this course?

You will gain the CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Falls Prevention Awareness.

What will I learn?

Learners are required to undertake the following units:

- Unit 1 Falls in context
- Unit 2 The risk factors and causes of falls
- Unit 3 Falls assessment and prevention
- Unit 4 Managing falls

*Learners must be 19 years+ and have lived in the UK/EU for 3 years.
