

## CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding the Safe Handling of Medication in Health and Social Care (QCF 13 Credits)

### What are the specific details?

<b>Duration</b>	You have up to eight weeks to complete the course.
<b>Venue</b>	Run via distance learning and can therefore be fitted around work and personal life.

### Who is this course suitable for?
