

CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Working with People with Mental Health Needs (QCF 18 Credits)

What are the specific details?

Duration	You have up to eight weeks to complete the course.
Venue	Run via distance learning and can therefore be fitted around work and personal life.
Cost	Free (fully government funded)*.

This qualification aims to raise awareness of mental health problems and the process and approaches involved in the care and support of those who experience mental ill health.

Who is this course suitable for?

This course is suitable for anyone working in the health and social care or a related sector that wish to understand mental health issues and support approaches.

Do I need any experience?

There aren't any specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. However this course is of specific interest to those working in health and social care or related sectors.

How is the course delivered?

The programme is delivered online or through a workbook by a range of assessments. These are assessed by the tutor throughout the programme from induction to completion.

What will I gain from this course?

You will gain the CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Working with People with Mental Health Needs (QCF 18 Credits).

What will I learn?

Learners are required to undertake the following units:

- Unit 1 Understand the role of the mental health worker
- Unit 2 Mental health and mental health issues
- Unit 3 Understand duty of care in adult health and social care
- Unit 4 Approaches to care and management in mental health
- Unit 5 Understanding change and support in relation to mental health

*Learners must be 19 years+ and have lived in the UK/EU for 3 years.
