

NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Equality and Diversity (QCF 18 Credits)

What are the specific details?

Duration	You have up to eight weeks to complete the course.
Venue	Run via distance learning and can therefore be fitted around work and personal life.
Cost	Free (fully government funded)*.

This distance learning course provides an introduction to the issues around stereotyping, prejudice and discrimination. It helps to identify the basic rights that everyone should enjoy, the shared values people have and looks at the responsibilities each person and organisation has in ensuring that barriers to participation in society are removed.

Who is this course suitable for?

Suitable for learners with some awareness of this area who want to develop their knowledge to aid their employment opportunities and for those in employment as part of their continuous professional development.

Do I need any experience?

There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification.

How is the course delivered?

The programme is delivered online by a range of assessments. These are assessed by the tutor throughout the programme from induction to completion.

What will I gain from this course?

You will gain the NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Equality and Diversity (QCF 18 Credits).

Learners are required to undertake the following units:

- Unit 1 Equality and diversity in society
- Unit 2 Equality and diversity in the community
- Unit 3 Equality and diversity in the workplace
